

# FIL — LUGE







All General Principles apply unless expressly mentioned otherwise hereafter (in particular in relation to size, frequency or location). Please refer to the General Guidelines (released in December 2024) to obtain the general principles of Authorised Identifications on NOC uniforms at the Olympic Games. This section provides visual illustrations regarding the placement and size of Sport Specific Implementation for any items.

# SUBMISSION PROCESS

#### Section 16 of General Guidelines apply

No additional obligatory submission process required by the IF, section 16 of the General Guidelines applies.

# 01 ATHLETE

## Identification of the Manufacturer

#### Clothing

- Competition clothing/
- Warm-up & Training suits One Identification of the Manufacturer per clothing

item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 30cm<sup>2</sup>. One Identification of the Manufacturer will be permitted on zippers and buttons and should appear in the same colour as the concerned item (i.e. tone on tone), as long as such identifications are deemed not conspicuous by the IOC.

One-piece bodysuit

One Identification of the Manufacturer [ ] shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum sizes noted above: however, these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.

Collars/Roll necks

If a roll neck or polo shirt is worn, no Identification of the Manufacturer may appear on the collar or on the neck. Only one Identification of the Manufacturer will be allowed; it may be situated on the chest, with a maximum size of 30cm<sup>2</sup>.

- Socks One Identification of the Manufacturer per accessorv item will be permitted, to a maximum size of 10 cm<sup>2</sup>.
- Gloves

One Identification of the Manufacturer [ ] per accessory item will be permitted, with a maximum size of 8cm<sup>2</sup> per glove; (Race gloves with max. of 15cm<sup>2</sup> per glove).

 Headgear/caps/Beanies One Identification of the Manufacturer per item, with a maximum size of 10cm<sup>2</sup> or two Identifications of the Manufacturer per accessory item will be permitted, with a maximum size of 5cm<sup>2</sup> each and placed above each ear.

# May carry the Identification of the Manufacturer as

generally used on products sold through the retail trade at least six (6) months before the Olympic Winter Games, with the identifications permitted on the lenses so long as such identifications are tone-on-tone, engraved into the lens and are not deemed as conspicuous by the IOC.

### Sport Equipment

Helmet

Evewear

May carry the Identification of the Manufacturer [ ] as generally used on products sold through speciality shops at least six (6)months before the Olympic Winter Games. No aerodynamic elements may be attached to the helmet

Goggles/Plexiglass/Visors

May carry the Identification of the Manufacturer as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Olympic Winter Games, with the identifications permitted on the lenses (e.g. goggles, plexiglass, visors) so long as such identifications are tone-ontone, engraved into the lens and are not deemed as conspicuous by the IOC.

Race Gloves

One Identification of the Manufacturer per accessory item will be permitted, with a maximum size of 15cm<sup>2</sup> per glove.

### Accessories

Bag

One Identification of the Manufacturer per bag will be permitted, covering no more than 10% of the surface, to a maximum size of 60cm<sup>2</sup>.

Shoes

All footwear items may carry the Identification of the Manufacturer as displayed on products sold through the retail consumer market at least six (6) months before the Olympic Winter Games.

# **Product Technology Identification**

## Clothing

 Competition clothing/ Warm-up & Training suits One additional Product Technology Identification will be permitted per clothing item, to a maximum size of 10cm<sup>2</sup>.

#### One-piece bodysuit

One Product Technology Identification

[ •] shall be permitted above the waist and below the waist, in accordance with the maximum sizes noted above: however, these identifications shall not be placed immediately adjacent to each other.

## NOC Emblem and National Identity

Additional IF Specifications

#### Section 07 Third Party Identifications (Athletes names)

The athlete's names may be displayed twice on the back of the helmet and shall not exceed more than 15mm.

Athletes may also have their names on their Steel protectors to allow for easy identification during the Olympic Winter Games.

#### Section 09

NOC Emblems and National Identity (National flags/emblems/codes)

#### Race suits

No IF Specific regulations with regards to National Identifications, section 07 of the General Guidelines applies.

#### Helmets

The national flag and/or NOC [ ] emblem is permitted on the helmet to a maximum size of 30cm<sup>2</sup>.

# **02 EQUIPMENT**

## Identification of the Manufacturer

#### Sport Equipment

Sled/Pod

Two Identifications of the Manufacturer [ per each side of the pod. In any case, the total identification area shall not cover more than 10% of the sled surface, to a maximum size of 60cm<sup>2</sup> on each side of the pod, and so long as the manufacturer is deemed a sports brand.

Sled/Runners

One floating Identification of the Manufacturer [ ] per runner. In any case, the total identification area shall not cover more than 10% of the runner's surface, to a maximum size of 60cm<sup>2</sup> on each runner, and so long as the manufacturer is deemed a sports brand.

The athlete illustration is for illustrative purposes only. If no identification is mentioned, there is no IF specific regulation.
